

ANNEX

In accordance with Article 12(4A) of Council Regulation (EC) No 1005/2008 of 29 September 2008 establishing a Community system to prevent, deter and eliminate illegal, unreported and unregulated fishing, as it forms part of UK law under the European Union (Withdrawal) Act 2018 (“the IUU Regulation”), the catch certificates provided for in Article 12 and Annex II of the IUU Regulation will be replaced – for fisheries products obtained from catches made by fishing vessels flying the Norwegian flag – by the Norwegian catch certificate, based on the Norwegian system of sales notes, which is an electronic traceability system under the control of the Norwegian authorities ensuring the same level of control by authorities as required under the IUU Regulation catch certification scheme.

A specimen of the Norwegian catch certificate which will replace the IUU Regulation Catch Certificate and Re-export Certificate are given in Appendix I.

Documents referred to in Article 14(1) and (2) of the IUU Regulation may be established, validated and submitted by electronic means.

Norway will require a catch certificate for landings and imports to Norway of catches made by fishing vessels flying the flag of the United Kingdom. A specimen of the IUU Regulation catch certificate to be issued by the United Kingdom is attached hereto as Appendix II.

The Norwegian system of sales notes will also be used to issue and validate a catch certificate for export consignments from Norway to the United Kingdom of conventional fishery products including stock-fish, salted fish and salted and dried klippfish, using raw material from small fishing vessels and/or involving production comprising several steps in the production process.

The current specific arrangements for prior notice of landings or imports from Norwegian fishing vessels to designated United Kingdom ports will continue to apply and will include the notification of catch certificates.

The United Kingdom and Norway decide to facilitate the exchange of information and administrative cooperation between respective competent authorities.

The United Kingdom and Norway decide to meet upon request to adjust, if necessary, the arrangements set out in this Annex.
